

How to Connect Your Devices to the School Wireless Network

A Guide for Prep School Pupils



Hello, welcome to this guide. We will show you how to connect your device to the school network. The school network is a special network that lets you use the internet and access online learning. You need to connect your device to the school network before you can use your device at school.

There are different types of devices that you can use. You might have a Windows laptop, a Mac laptop, iPhone, or an Android phone. Each device has a different way of connecting to the school network. We will explain each one in this guide.

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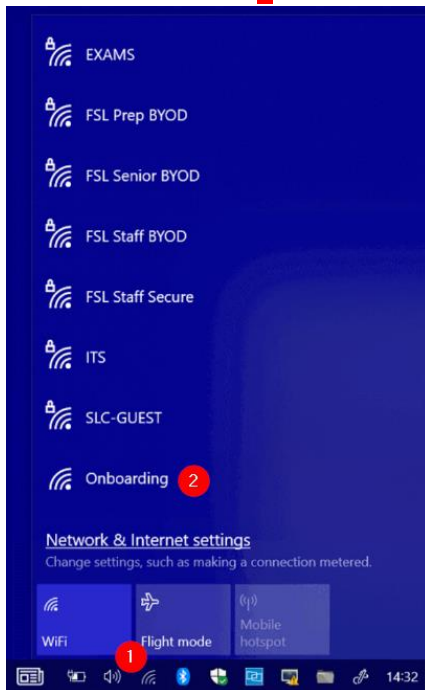
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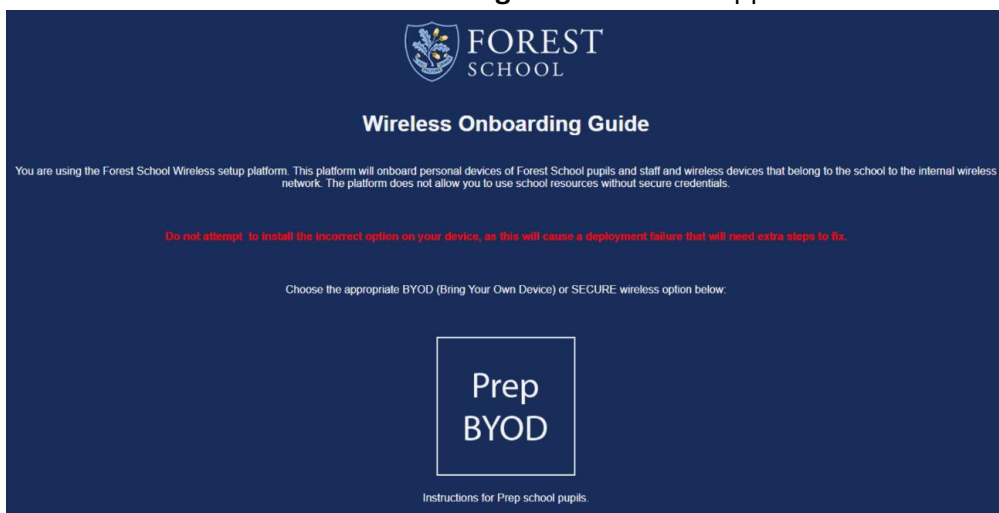


Connect a Windows Laptop to the School Network

1. On your Windows laptop, go to the bottom right corner of the screen and click on the Wi-Fi icon marked with **1** in the below image.

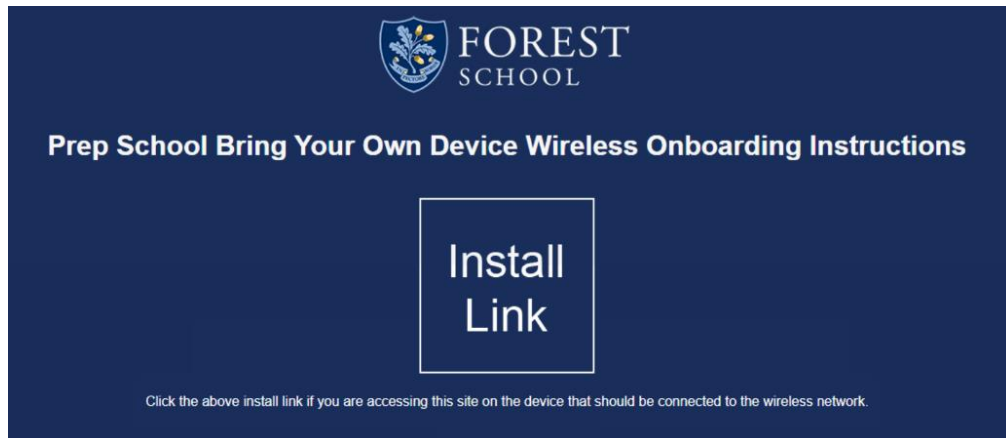


2. Look for the network called Onboarding marked with **2** in the above image. Click on it.
3. A “Forest School Wireless Onboarding Guide” website appear.

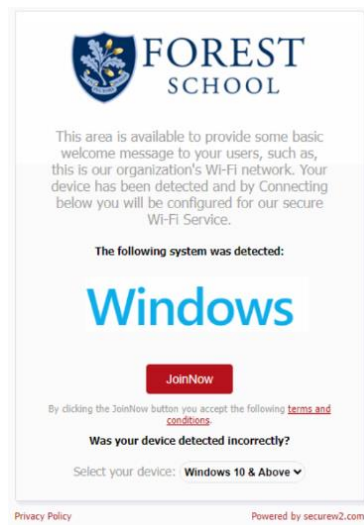


4. Select **Prep BYOD**.

5. Select **Install Link**.



6. A screen with a “Join Now” button will appear.



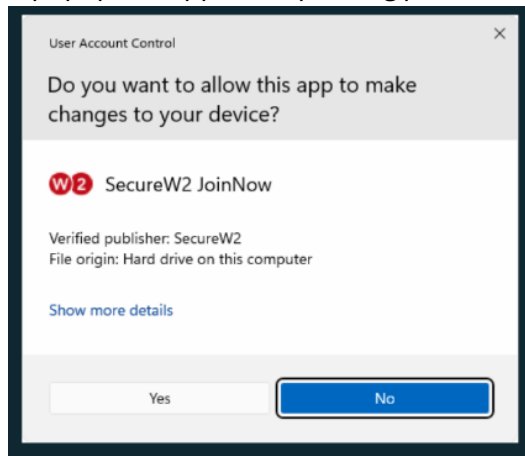
7. Select **Join Now**.

8. This will download a file to your download folder.



9. Select “Open File” from the browser Downloads folder.

10. A popup will appear requesting permission to run the SecureW2 JoinNow application.




11. Select Yes.

12. The SecureW2 wizard will appear.




13. Select Next.


14. A screen will pop up asking you to enter your username. This is your Forest School email account that you use to log in to your school account. Tap **Next**.

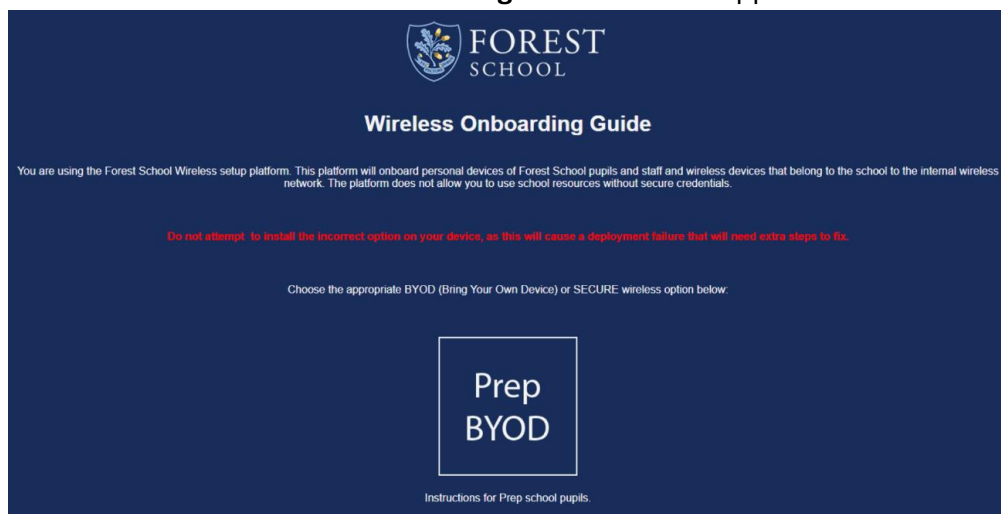


18. Click Done.

Connect a Mac Laptop to the School Network

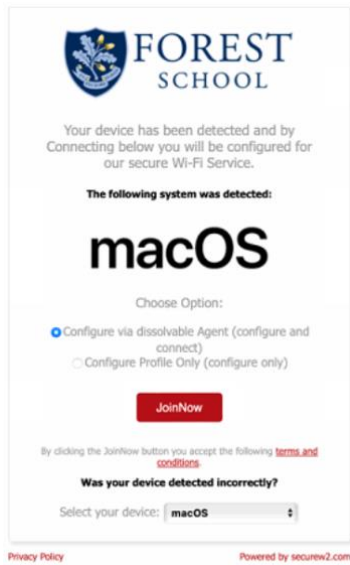
1. On your Mac laptop, go to the top right corner of the screen and click on the Wi-Fi icon.
2. Look for the network name that starts with **Onboarding**. Click on it.
3. A “**Forest School Wireless Onboarding Guide**” website appear.



4. Select **Staff BYOD**.
5. Select **Install Link**.

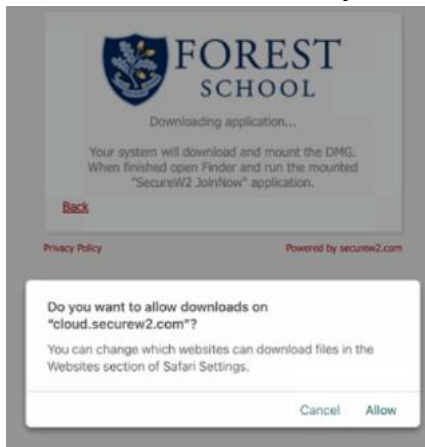


6. A screen with a “Join Now” button will appear.

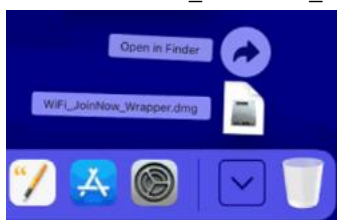


7. Select **Join Now**.

9. Select the Wifi_JoinNow_Wrapper.dmg file from Downloads folder.



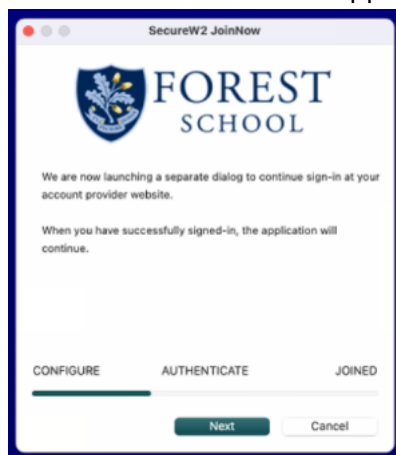
10. A popup will appear with the SecureW2 JoinNow application. Open the application.



11. Select **Open** on the next popup.




12. The SecureW2 wizard will appear. Select Next.




13. The security prompt will appear. Select OK.




14. A screen will pop up asking you to enter your username. This is your Forest School email account that you use to log in to your school account. Tap **Next**.

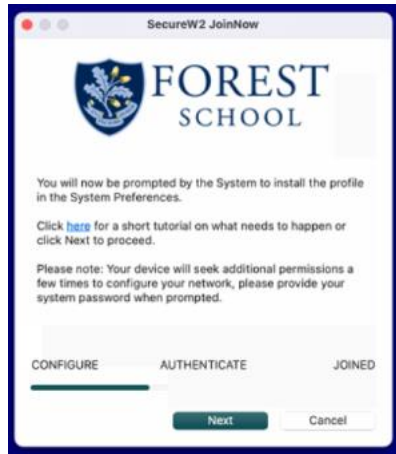

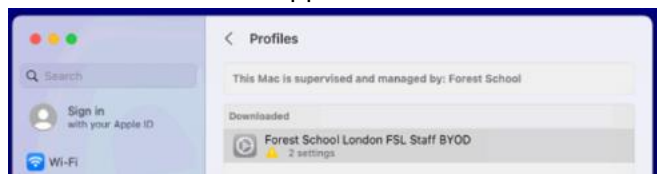

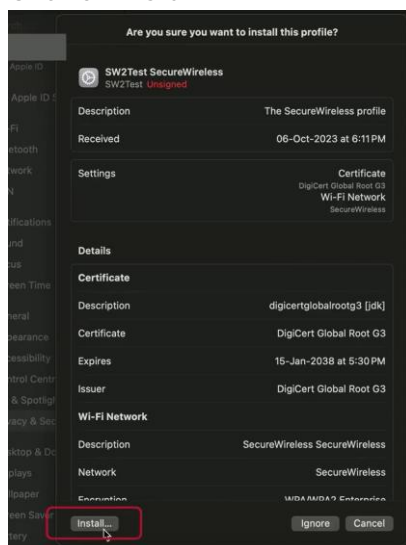
17. Select **Next**.

20. Click on **Install**.



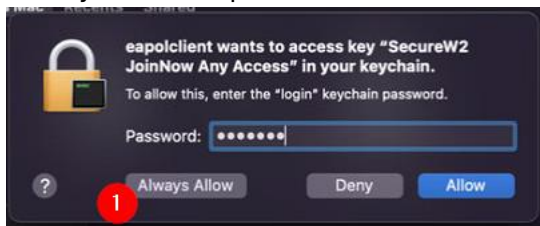
21. Enter your device password.



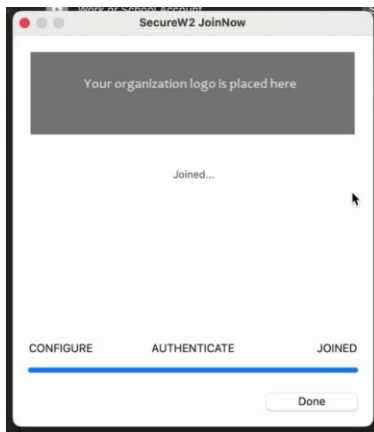
22. Click **Allow**.

iPhone

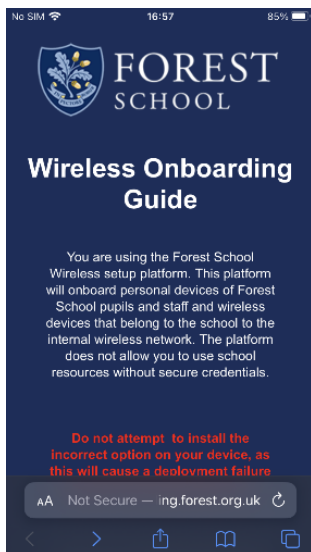
Connect an iPhone or iPad to the School Network

It is important that this process is followed on the **Safari** browser app on an iPhone. Please configure Safari as your default browser app **before** following these steps.

1. On your iPhone or iPad, go to Settings.



2. Tap on Wi-Fi.
3. Look for the network called **Onboarding**. Tap on it to connect.
4. A “Forest School Wireless Onboarding Guide” website appear.

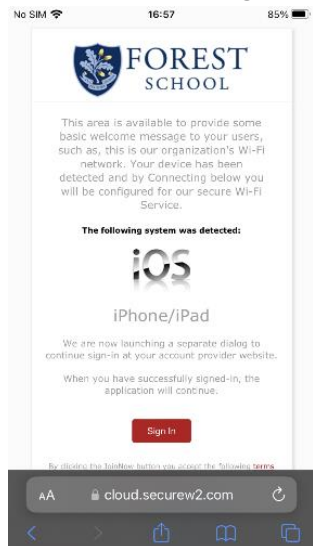


5. Scroll down and select **Prep BYOD**.

6. Select **Install Link**.

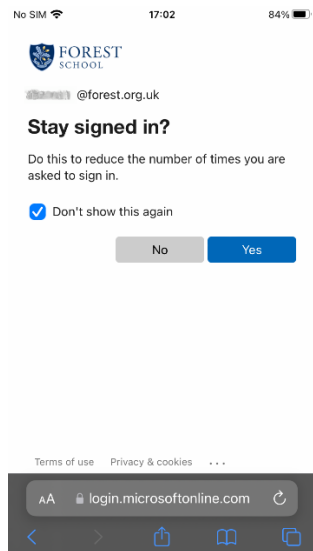

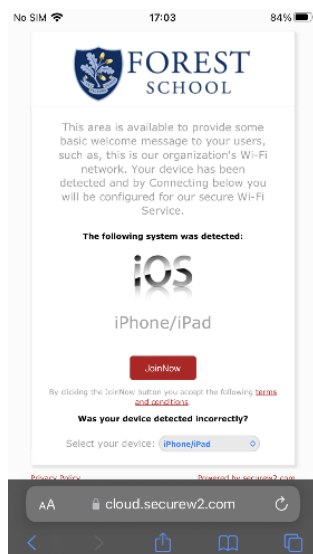

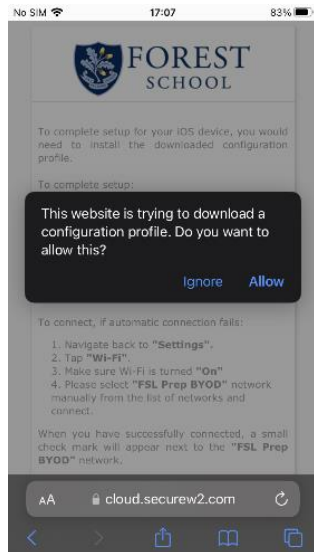
11. Select “Don’t show this again” and select **Yes**.



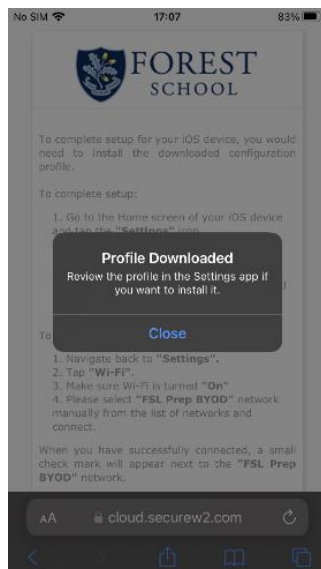
12. Select **JoinNow**.



13. A message will appear asking if you want to allow a configuration profile. Select **Allow**.



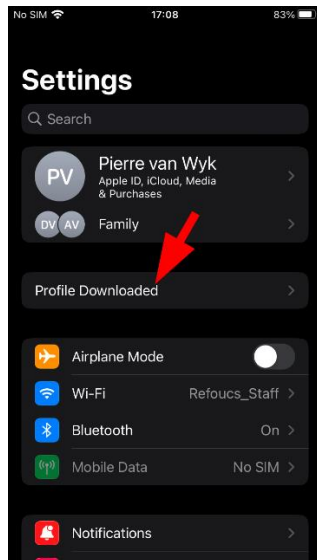
14. Select **Close** on the next message.



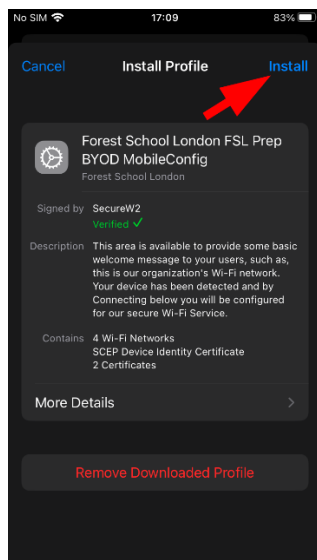
15. Go to your phone **Settings**.



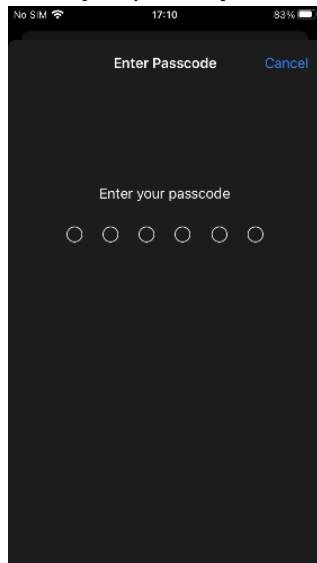
16. Select **Profile Downloaded**.



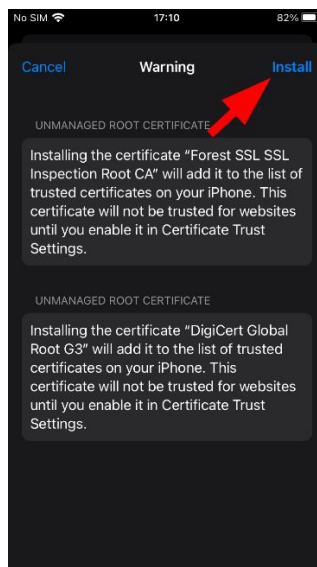
17. Select **Install**.

19. Select **Install**.

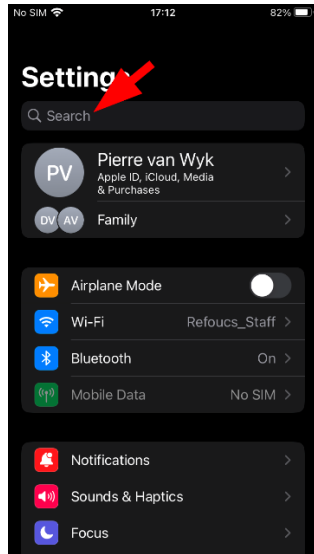


20. Select **Done**.

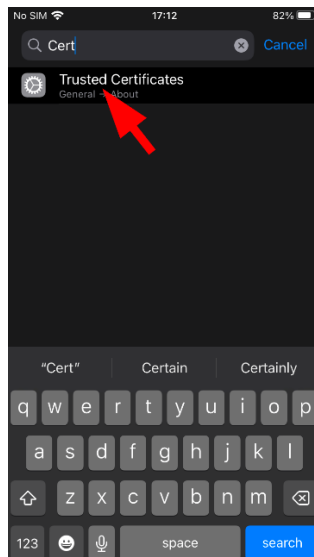
21. Go back to Settings.



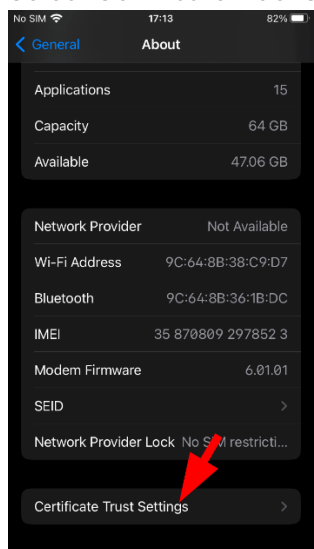
22. Search for “cert”



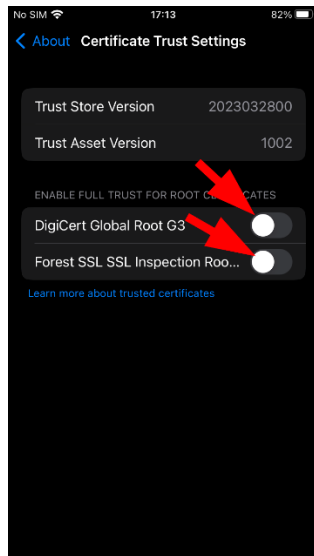
23. Select Trusted Certificates



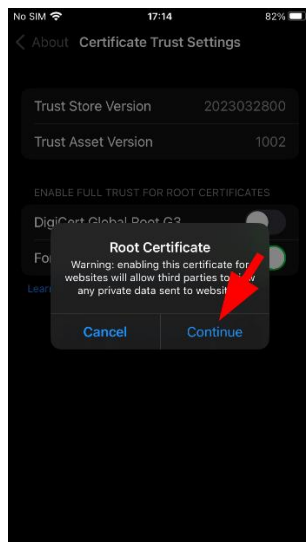
24. Select Certificate Trust Settings right at the bottom.

26. Select Continue.

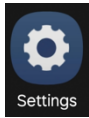


27. Congratulations, you have connected your iPhone to the school network. You can now use the internet and online learning on your iPhone.

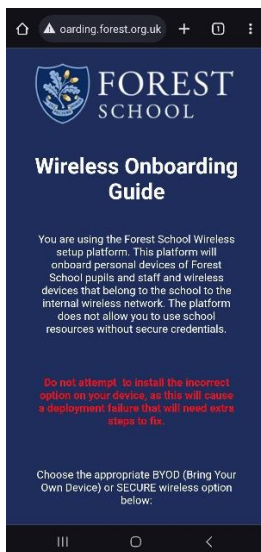


Connect an Android Phone to the School Network

1. On your Android phone, go to Settings.

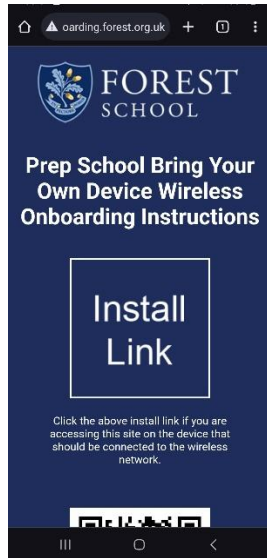


2. Tap on Connections.
3. Tap on Wi-Fi.
4. Look for the network called **Onboarding**. Tap on it to connect.
5. A “**Forest School Wireless Onboarding Guide**” website appear.

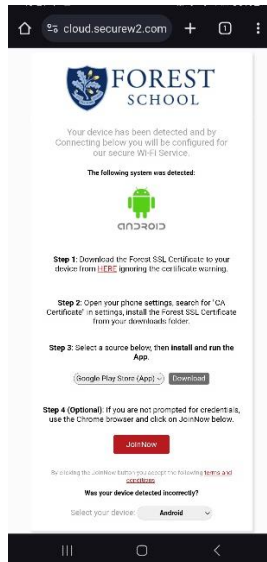


6. Scroll down and select **Prep BYOD**.

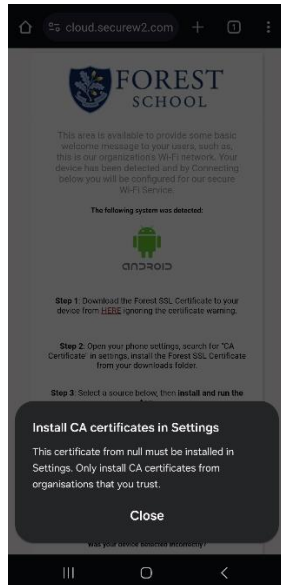
7. Select **Install Link**.



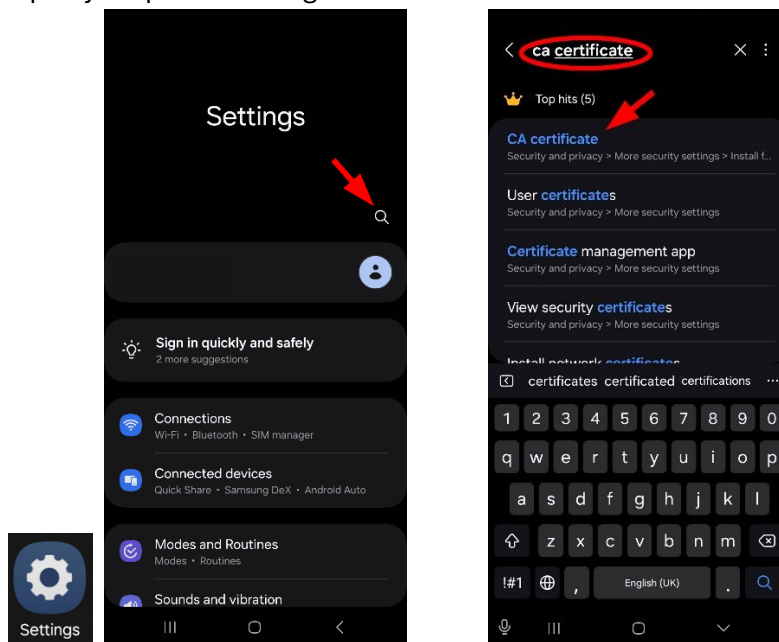
8. Click on the red **HERE** link to download a file on **Step 1**.



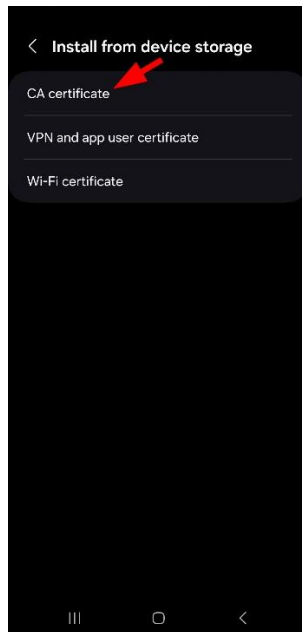
9. Click on Close.



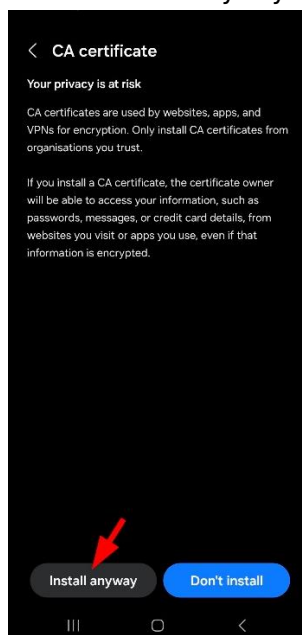
10. Open your phone settings then search for “CA Certificate” and click on it.



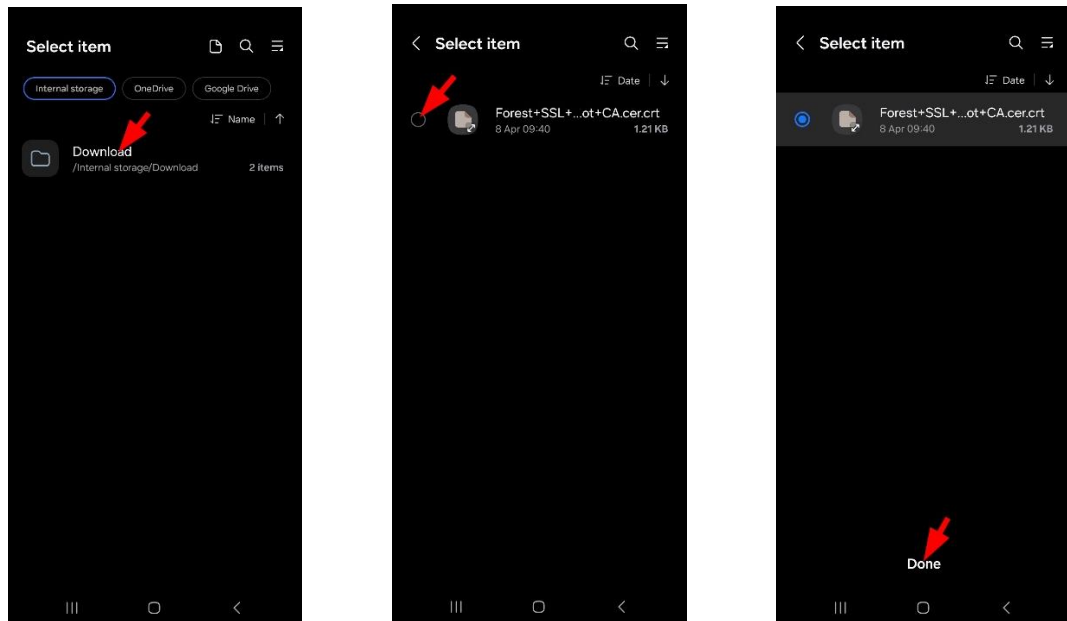
11. Select CA Certificate.



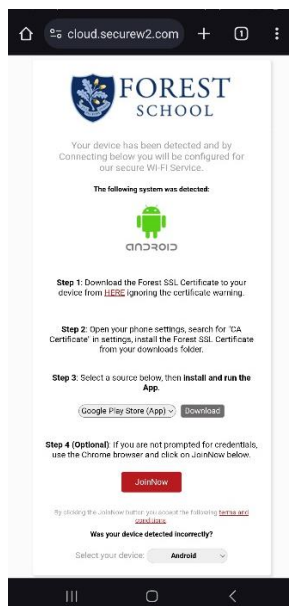
12. Select “Install anyway”



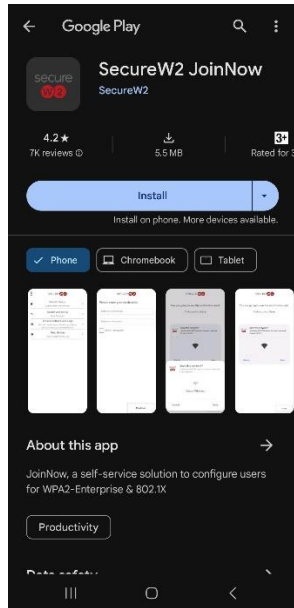
13. Open your Download folder, select the Forest+SSL+...ot+CA.cer.crt file and select Done.



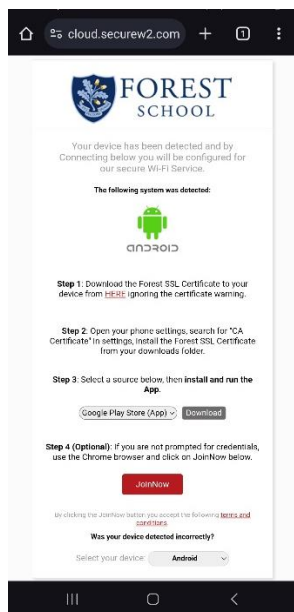
14. Go back to Step 3 on the “Forest School Wireless Onboarding Guide” website then select **Download** on Step 3.

16. Go back to Step 4 on the “**Forest School Wireless Onboarding Guide**” website. Click **JoinNow**.



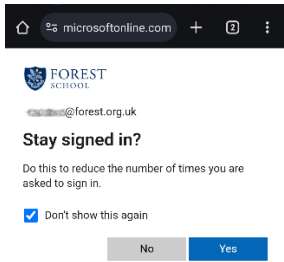

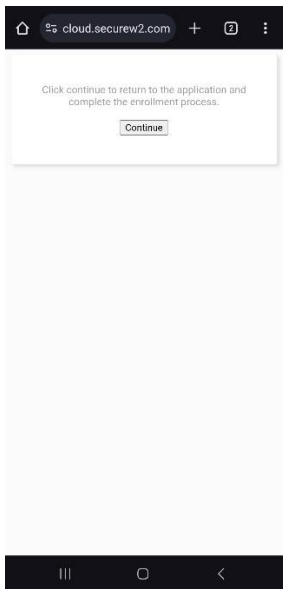
18. Enter your password on the next screen. Tap **Sign In**.

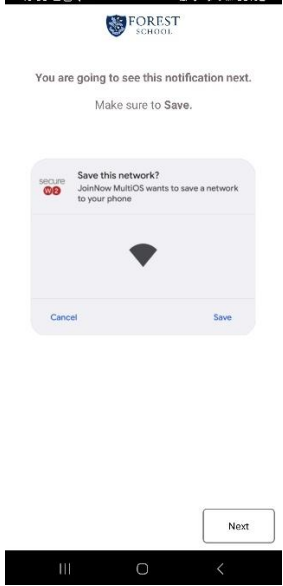

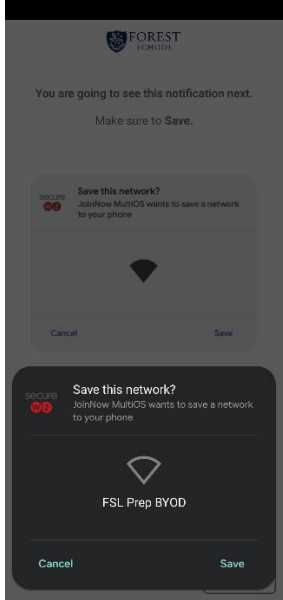
